PRINCE2 Agile combines the world's most used project management method with agile behaviours, concepts and techniques making it the most complete agile project management method.

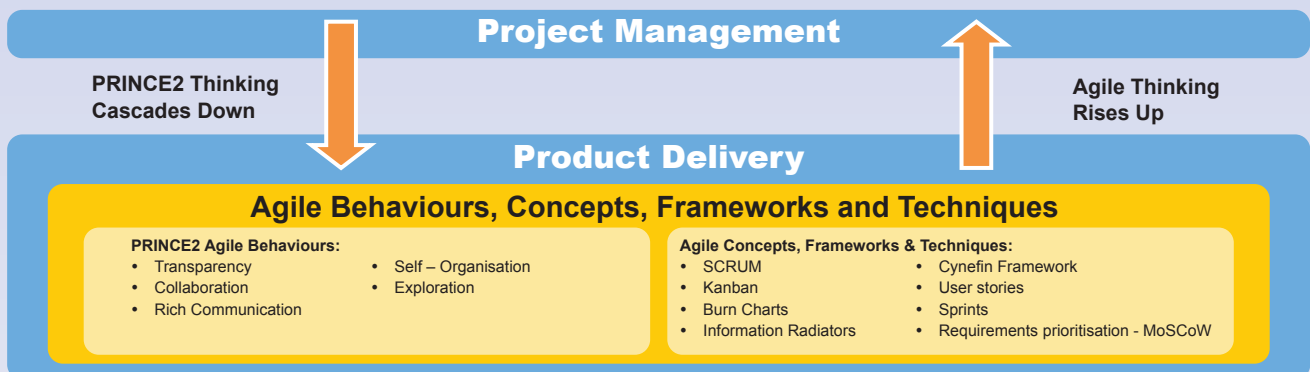
It provides insights on the application of PRINCE2® in an agile environment, giving organizations greater flexibility and responsiveness in dynamic business environments.

To complete PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner certification participants require certification in either: PRINCE2 Foundation or Practitioner; PRINCE2 Agile Foundation, Project Management Professional[®] (PMP); Certified Associate in Project Management[®] (CAPM); IMPA Levels A, B, C or D[®] (Certified Projects Director).

Exam: The Foundation exam is a closed book, 1 hour multiple-choice exam with 50 questions and a pass mark of 28 (56%). The Practitioner exam is an open book, 2.5 hour multiple-choice exam, based on a given scenario. There are 50 questions with a pass mark of 30 (60%).
